

Manchester airport is 59 miles from the University and has excellent train and motorway links to Leeds. The two main train services connecting Manchester Airport to Leeds Train Station are [Northern Rail](#) and [Transpennine Express](#) services. Please note that there are different types of tickets, some are valid on all trains while some are valid only on Northern Rail or TransPennine but not both. If in doubt, ask the staff members at the train station.

Alternatively, you can also take a bus (please read the section for buses on our websites). At the airport, the bus terminal and the train station are both next to each other, so you can follow the same signs as “The Station”.

When you have passed the border control and pass the no-return gates, please look for **The Station** sign (example shown below):



You will walk through an above-ground tunnel (called SkyLink) that will take you directly to the Train Station in few minutes (see the screenshot below):



If you have not purchased the train tickets online, then you can buy on the spot from the service desk (or self-service machine) as shown below:
